


New York **Nursing Home Cost Index** October 2016




\$121,920 **Average Annual Cost** (Semi-Private Room)

Days Nursing Home Medicare pays for up to 100

days in a nursing home for rehabilitation after a qualifying hospital stay for strokes and procedures such as heart surgery, hip replacements and major surgeries.

Medicaid **Nursing Home**

Medicaid replaces Medicare for seniors who qualify based on very low-income and assets. Benefits vary by state as Medicaid is funded by both state and federal taxes.
